## Reader's Theater Performance Rubric

### Accuracy

- 4 – Reads words correctly throughout; self-corrects quickly.
- 3 – Mostly accurate; occasional miscues.
- 2 – Several errors; needs support to self-correct.
- 1 – Frequent miscues; interferes with meaning.

### Fluency (Pace)

- 4 – Natural pace that enhances script.
- 3 – Generally appropriate pace.
- 2 – Sometimes too fast/slow.
- 1 – Pace disrupts the script.

### Expression (Prosody)

- 4 – Expressive voice brings character to life.
- 3 – Some expression; attempts character voice.
- 2 – Limited expression.
- 1 – No expression; monotone.

### Volume & Clarity

- 4 – Loud, clear, easy to hear.
- 3 – Mostly audible; occasional fading.
- 2 – Volume varies; sometimes hard to hear.
- 1 – Often too quiet or unclear.

### Tracking / Cues

- 4 – Always follows; perfect cues.
- 3 – Usually follows; minor delays.
- 2 – Sometimes loses place.
- 1 – Frequently off-task; misses cues.

### Participation & Collaboration

- 4 – Fully engaged; excellent teamwork.
- 3 – Participates well; respectful.
- 2 – Inconsistent engagement.
- 1 – Off-task or disruptive.

### Preparedness

- 4 – Clearly practiced; polished performance.
- 3 – Prepared; shows practice.
- 2 – Limited practice.
- 1 – Not prepared.
